

Protect yourself from Hepatitis C

FACT:

About 2.4 million people in the U.S. have Hepatitis C. Most are unaware of their infection.

Hepatitis C is a contagious liver disease from infection with the Hepatitis C virus (HCV). It spreads from the blood of an infected person.

Do not share needles or other equipment to inject cosmetic substances, drugs, or steroids.



Blood on personal items can spread Hepatitis C.



Do not share razors, nail clippers, toothbrushes, or glucose monitors that may have come in contact with an infected person's blood.

Hepatitis C infection now affects every generation of adults.

Every adult over 18 years of age should be tested at least once for this curable infection. All pregnant women should be tested.
